RESOLUTION NO. 2011- 18

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING WATER RATES AND
OTHER CHARGES FOR FURNISHING WATER SERVICE
FROM THE WATER SYSTEM OF RED LION MUNICIPAL
AUTHORITY**

WHEREAS, Red Lion Municipal Authority (“Authority”) is a general municipality authority organized and existing under the Municipality Authorities Act, as amended (the “Act”), 53 Pa.C.S. §§ 5601-5622; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has the authority pursuant to Section 5607(d)(9) of the Act to fix, alter, charge and collect rates and other charges for the provision of water service to its customers; and

WHEREAS, the Authority desires to increase the rates and other charges for the provision of water service by the Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and it is hereby resolved as follows:

SECTION 1. Effective for all bills for services rendered on or after January 1, 2012, the Authority hereby fixes, adopts, establishes and imposes for water service the rates and charges set forth on Exhibit A attached to this Resolution.

SECTION 2. All prior water rate schedules or resolutions of the Authority are hereby repealed to the extent inconsistent herewith or necessary to give effect to the provisions of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. The provisions of this resolution shall be severable, and if any of its provisions or the application of any of its provisions shall for any reason be held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair the validity of any of the remaining provisions of the resolution and it is hereby declared as the intent of the Authority that this


resolution would have been enacted as if such unconstitutional, illegal or valid provision was not included.


SECTION 4. This Resolution shall be effective at 12:01 a.m. on January 1, 2012.





RATE SCHEDULE - 2012

Inclining Block w/2 tiers Residential Class Customers

Declining Block w/ 2 Tiers Commercial, Industrial and Institutional Class Customers

- (A) For all water delivered to Residential Consumers for each property located within the municipal boundaries of the Borough of Red Lion, York County, Pennsylvania (the "Borough"), the following rates and charges shall apply:

| 1" | \$8.50 | 2,000 gallons |

- (B) For all water delivered to Commercial, Industrial and Institutional Class Consumers for each property located within the municipal boundaries of the Borough of Red Lion, York County, Pennsylvania (the "Borough"), the following rates and charges shall apply:

| <u>Quantity</u> | <u>Per Month</u> |
|-------------------------|--------------------------|
| For first 1,000 gallons | \$5.80 per 1,000 gallons |
| Over 1,000 gallons | \$3.88 per 1,000 gallons |

Notwithstanding the rates scheduled above, the following minimum monthly charges are hereby established for rates and charges applicable under subsection B:

- (C) For all water delivered to Residential Class Consumers for each property located outside the municipal boundaries of the Borough, the following rates and charges shall apply:

| For first 1,000 gallons | \$4.65 per 1,000 gallons Minimum of \$4.65 per month |
| Over 1,000 gallons | \$5.78 per 1,000 gallons |

Notwithstanding the rates scheduled above, the following minimum monthly charges are hereby established for rates and charges applicable under this subsection C:

| <u>Size of Meter</u> | <u>Net Minimum</u> | <u>Allowance</u> |
|----------------------|--------------------|------------------|
| 5/8" x 3/4" | \$4.65 | 1,000 gallons |
| 1" | \$10.43 | 2,000 gallons |

- (D) For all water delivered to Commercial, Industrial and Institutional Class Customers for each property located outside the municipal boundaries of the Borough, the following rates and charges shall apply:

| <u>Quantity</u> | <u>Per Month</u> |
|-------------------------|--|
| For first 1,000 gallons | \$6.90 per 1,000 gallons Minimum \$6.90 per month |
| Over 1,000 gallons | \$4.65 per 1,000 gallons |

RESOLUTION NO. 2011- 17

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING SEWER RATES AND
OTHER CHARGES FOR FURNISHING SEWER SERVICE
FROM THE SEWER SYSTEM OF RED LION MUNICIPAL
AUTHORITY**

WHEREAS, Red Lion Municipal Authority (“Authority”) is a general municipality authority organized and existing under the Municipality Authorities Act, as amended (the “Act”), 53 Pa.C.S. §§ 5601-5622; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has the authority pursuant to Section 5607(d)(9) of the Act to fix, alter, charge and collect rates and other charges for the provision of sewer service to its customers; and

WHEREAS, the Authority desires to increase the rates and other charges for the provision of sewer service by the Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and it is hereby resolved as follows:

SECTION 1. Effective for all bills for services rendered on or after January 1, 2012, the Authority hereby fixes, adopts, establishes and imposes for sewer service the following rates and charges:

METERED SEWER RATE SCHEDULE

| <u>Quantity</u> | <u>Per Month</u> |
|-----------------------|------------------------|
| First 1,000 Gallons | \$12.64/ 1,000 Gallons |
| 1,100 – 4,000 Gallons | \$6.70 / 1,000 Gallons |
| Over 4,000 Gallons | \$5.95 / 1,000 Gallons |

Notwithstanding the foregoing rate schedule, the minimum sewer rental or charge shall be \$12.64 per monthly billing cycle.

SECTION 2. All prior sewer rate schedules or resolutions of the Authority are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give effect to the provisions of this Resolution.


SECTION 3. The provisions of this resolution shall be severable, and if any of its provisions or the application of any of its provisions shall for any reason be held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair the validity of any of the remaining provisions of the resolution and it is hereby declared as the intent of the Authority that this resolution would have been enacted as if such unconstitutional, illegal or valid provision was not included.






